Archeological Dig: Exceptional Example

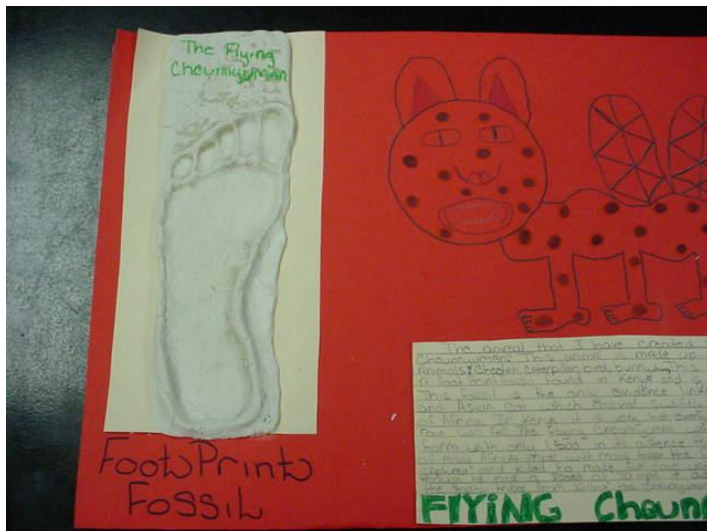
The students were assigned jobs and had to take very good notes of their dig to turn in. Good notes included a grid map of their “site” with the location of their findings noted, drawings of the artifacts that were found, and the proper mass measurements of their artifacts.

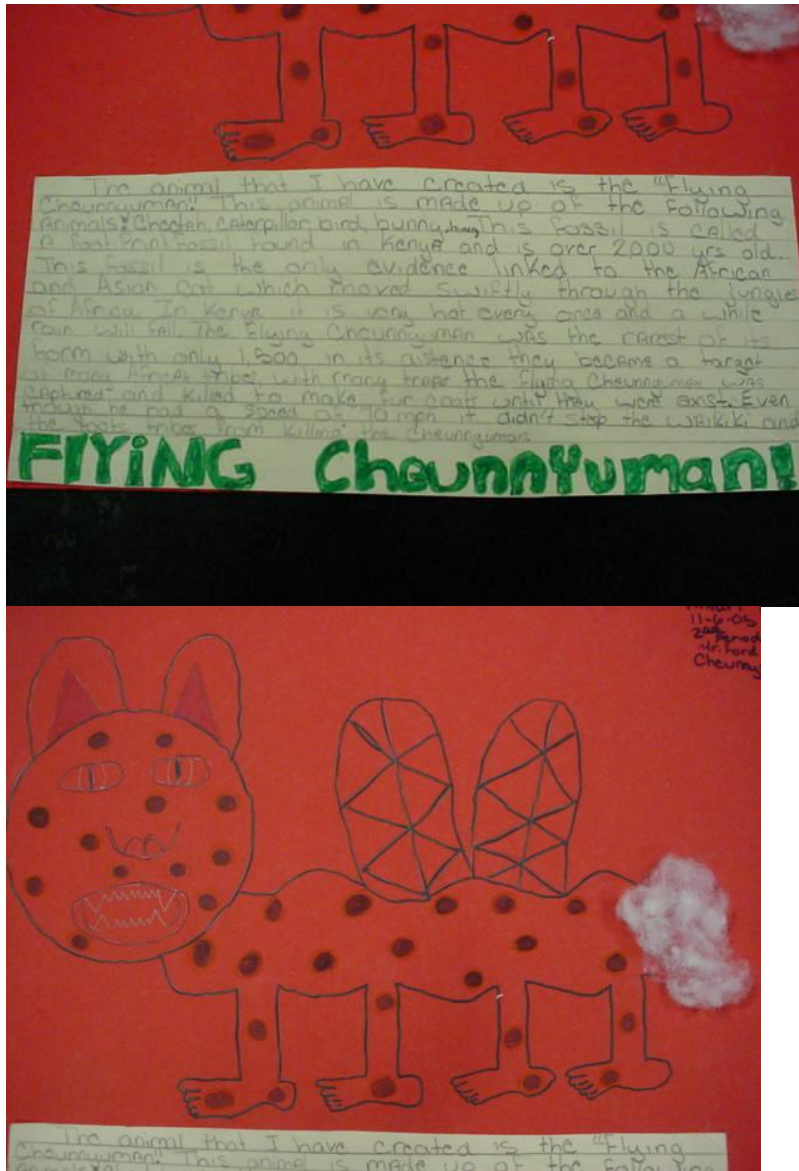
Archeological Dig: Mediocre Example

Students who turned in unsatisfactory notes did not include the grid map, the locations of their artifacts, or had incomplete or missing information.

Poster of Unknown Fossil: Exceptional Example

This poster was a good example because it included a picture of their organism, the type of fossil that was found, and a description of the organism.





Poster of Unknown Fossil: Mediocre Example

This poster had an excellent illustration but did not include a description of their organism or complete information about the specific type of fossil that was found.
